

Tawny Owls Curriculum Map

This term our theme is All About Me. We will learn about where we live, where we were born, our families and people who help us in our community.

In Literacy, we will retell stories using puppets, props, drawings and our own imagination. We will provide opportunities for mark making e.g. printing with paints using fruit, vegetables, vehicles, fingers and with other tools such as toothbrushes, feathers and string.

In Maths, we will be looking at numbers zero to five and representing these numbers on fingers, counting stamps, claps and jumps to 10 and beyond where appropriate.

In Physical Development, we will develop our spatial awareness by doing some running and jumping. We will use small tools to develop our fine motor skills for example pegboards.

In Personal, Social and Emotional Development, we are focusing on friendships. We will look at how to be a friend, be kind to others, sharing and telling an adult when there is a problem or when something doesn't feel right.

In Communication and Language Development, we will listen to others one on one or in small groups, join in with repeating refrains and anticipating key events and phrases in rhymes and stories and respond to simple instructions.

In Understanding the World, we will be talking about ourselves, families, where we live, people who help us and our community through the year.

In Expressive Arts and Design, we will be exploring paint, musical instruments and singing.
